Green Group Weekly Encouragement

Encouragements:

The arrival of lifestyle restrictions due to the Covid-19 pandemic, reinforced the idea of the '15-minute neighbourhood': a place where residents can access most needs within a short walk or bike ride of their home. Whilst not possible for everyone, modelling this concept in the way we travel will bring benefits to the climate, our health and our communities.

Warnings:

"Air quality meets the health-based air quality objectives across most areas of York except for three technical breach areas within the city centre which include the following roads: **Gillygate, Bootham, St Leonard's Place, Blossom Street, and Rougier Street.**" The report found the highest concentration of nitrogen dioxide in an area where somebody lives or spends a long period of time was 47 micrograms per metre cubed in Gillygate, seven micrograms per metre cubed over the limit.
