A New Garden

We plan to turn the bare space beside the new extension at St Andrew's into a lovely garden! We are looking for plant donations of especially (but not exclusively) native species, so if you are taking cuttings or dividing your perennials or bulbs at the moment, please put a few aside. The following are especially welcome: Cornus-colourful dog woods, Golden elder, Geraniums, Astrantia, Dead nettle especially the yellow flowered one, Vinca, Primroses, Honesty seedlings, Lungwort-lads and lasses, Arum- Lords and Ladies (aka Cuckoo pint), Ajuga, Iris-yellow flag, Hellebore, Purple and Yellow Loosestrife Grasses-and sedges, Ferns-Royal, Lady and Harts tongue. Bulbs-Snowdrops, Aconites, scilla, daffs, bluebells, Lily of the valley, Anemones. Thank you!
