A New Garden

We plan to turn the bare space beside the new extension at St Andrew's into a lovely garden! We are looking for plant donations of especially (but not exclusively) native species, so if you are taking cuttings or dividing your perennials or bulbs, please put a few aside. The following are especially welcome: Cornus-(colourful dogwoods), Golden elder, Geraniums, Astrantia, Dead nettle especially the yellow flowered one, Vinca, Primroses, Honesty seedlings, Lungwort-lads and lasses, Arum- Lords and Ladies (aka Cuckoo pint), Ajuga, Iris-yellow flag, Hellebore, Purple and Yellow Loosestrife Grasses-and sedges, Ferns (Royal, Lady and Harts tongue), bulbs-(snowdrops, aconites, scilla, daffs, bluebells, lily of the valley, anemones). Foodbank

The March data for our warehouse is in and shows that during the month we sent out 5.9 tonnes of food but only received 5.3 tonnes of donations. We were similarly around 5-700kg down in January and February, meaning we are around 1.8 tonnes lower than at the start of the year. Our weekly needs are always on our website at <https://york.foodbank.org.uk/give-help/donate-food/>. If you use the Bank The Food app, it shows you when you are in store exactly what we need. But no more beans please... we now have 2.3 tonnes of beans! (114 Crates) That's 15% of our total stock in beans alone, and they only make up <10% of a food parcel. In comparison we only have 30 crates of tinned tomatoes. So thank you, but we are ok for beans at the moment!
