Green Group suggestions for Lent

For Anglicans Lent is the time when we remember the 40 days that Jesus spent in the wilderness, facing challenge and temptation. It is a time when we reflect on God's purpose for our life. This year we challenge you to give up single-use plastics– to reduce the actions which damage God's Creation. "Over 8.3 billion tonnes of plastic have been produced since the 1950s. That's enough plastic to cover every inch of the UK ankle-deep more than ten times over. Just 9% was recycled!"

1 Give up disposable cups & drinks in plastic bottles: Carry a travel mug or water bottle. Get a reusable bottle, fill it up with tap water before leaving the house and refill it wherever you happen to be.

2 Take your own reusable bags: Plastic bags and produce bags in particular are often used for minutes before being discarded. Most plastic bags are not recycled, ending up in landfills.
